Northern View Community is an apartment community featuring mostly two-bedroom apartments with many amenities. It is designed for students with dependents, spouses or domestic partners, students in graduate or law programs, or undergraduate students age 20 or older.

* **Shuttle** pickup at **NORTHWEST** entrance of Holmes Student Center for Business, Nursing, and Engineering Tours. **Shuttle runs continuously beginning at 10 a.m.**

** **Lincoln & Heritage rooms** – located on the 2nd floor of the south side of the student center. Go to the main stairs at the Martin Luther King Commons entrance to the Holmes Student Center. Go up one flight of stairs to the second floor. You will see signage indicating the appropriate room location. Elevators are available on the main floor past the hotel desk.

*** **Holmes Student Center** – 3rd and 7th floors and Skyroom - Use elevators past the hotel guest room desk.

**** **Diversions Lounge** – located on the ground floor. Go to the main stairs at the Martin Luther King Commons entrance. Go down one flight of stairs to the ground floor. Diversions Lounge is on the right past the University Bookstore and TCF Bank. Elevators are on the main floor past the hotel desk.

The last shuttle to the Convocation Center parking area leaves the Holmes Student Center at 4 p.m.
