Offices generally support three kinds of seating assignment:

- Shift/Workshop: People take a seat for a given time-shift. The seat is then released to another person on the next time-shift.
- Assigned: One and only one person is assigned to one or more workstations. Likewise, the workstations are assigned to be used exclusively by one person.
- Unassigned: A person is not assigned to any particular workstation. Likewise, the workstation is not assigned to any particular person.

You may also find that people may need different kinds of workstations at different times for different tasks (e.g. an enclosed office one day and open space the next and a war room the next - all within the same office). This means that workers' needs are not only inter-office (travelers and teleworkers), but intra-office. We want to work with you and fit your team into our Chicago team.

Location

NIU Chicago office bound by LaSalle Street to the west, Washington Street to the north, Calhoun Street to the south, and 111 West Washington to the east.
