

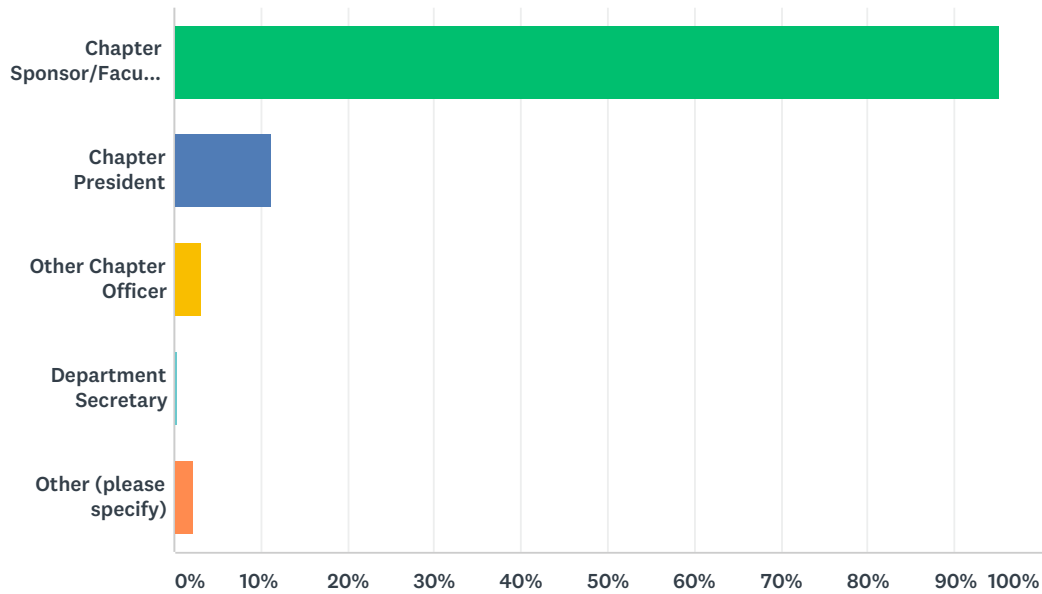

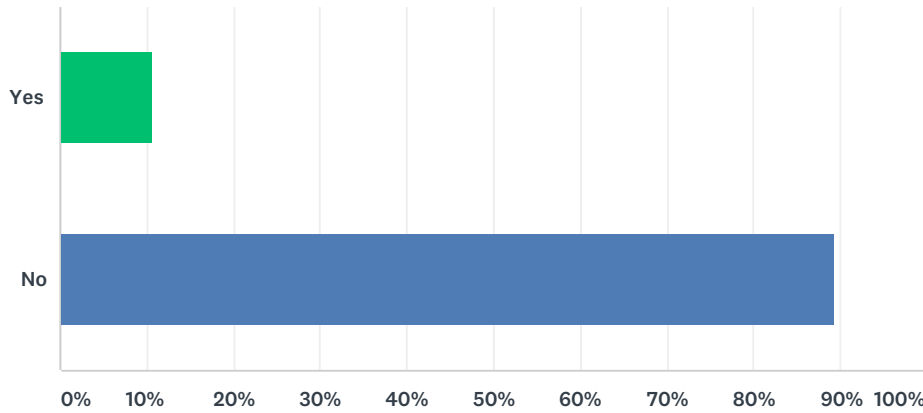

Q3 Was your chapter chartered or reactivated during the fall 2017 - spring 2018 academic year?

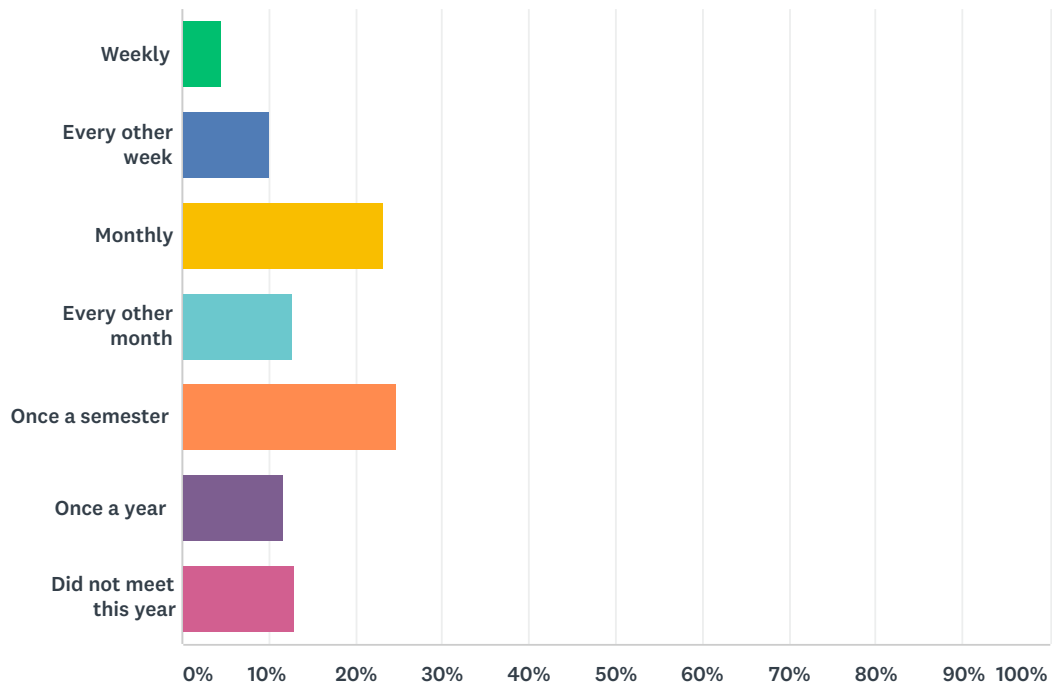

Q4 Chapter Meetings: Approximately how often does your chapter hold chapter meetings?

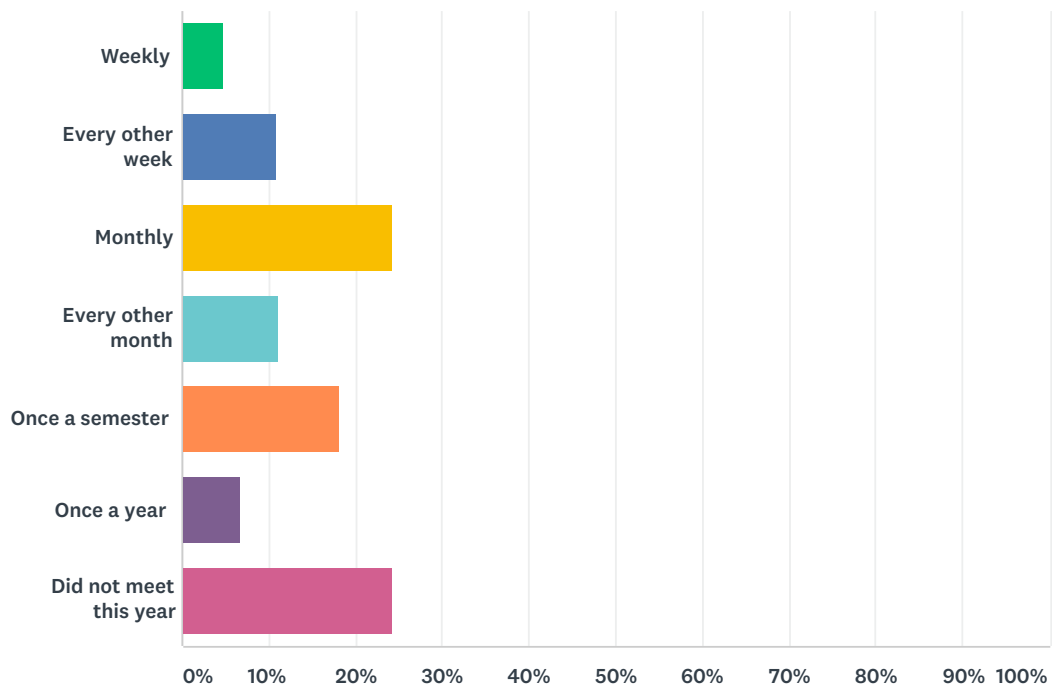

Q5 Officer Meetings: Approximately how often does your chapter hold officer meetings?

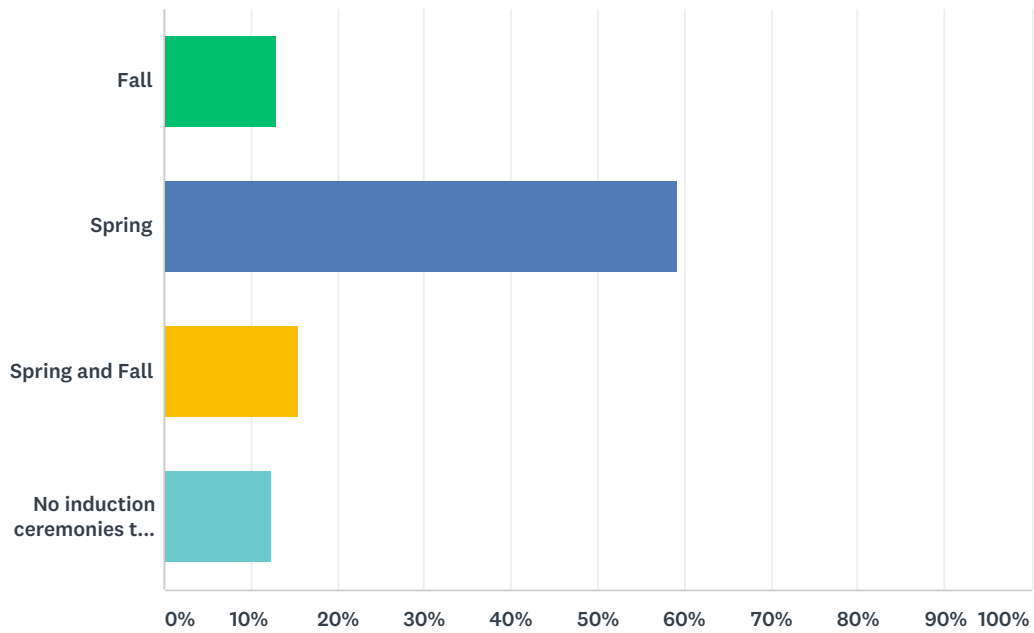

Q6 Induction Ceremonies: When does your chapter hold induction ceremonies for new members?

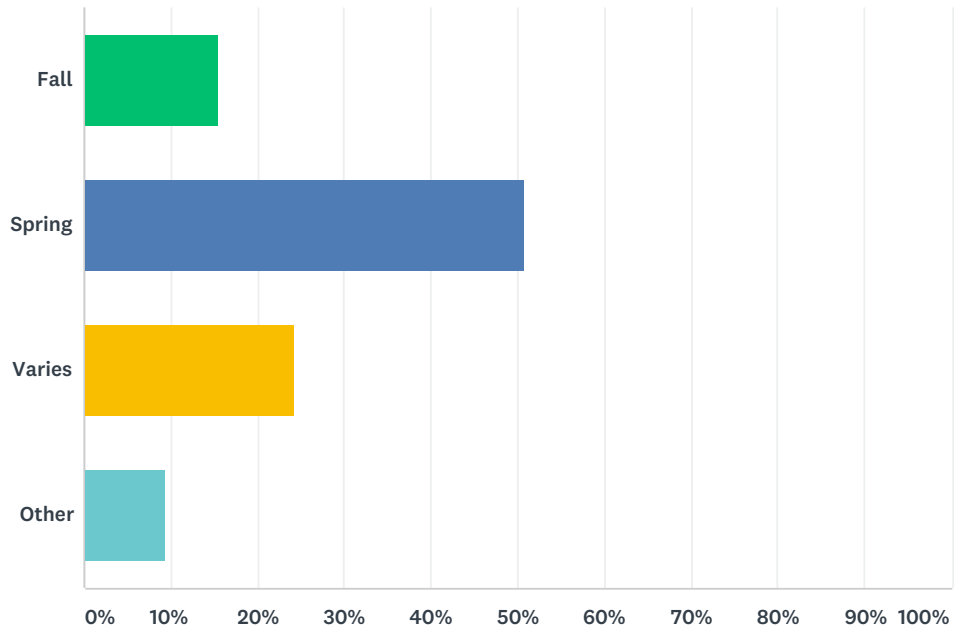

Q7 Chapter Officers: When does your chapter elect Chapter Officers?

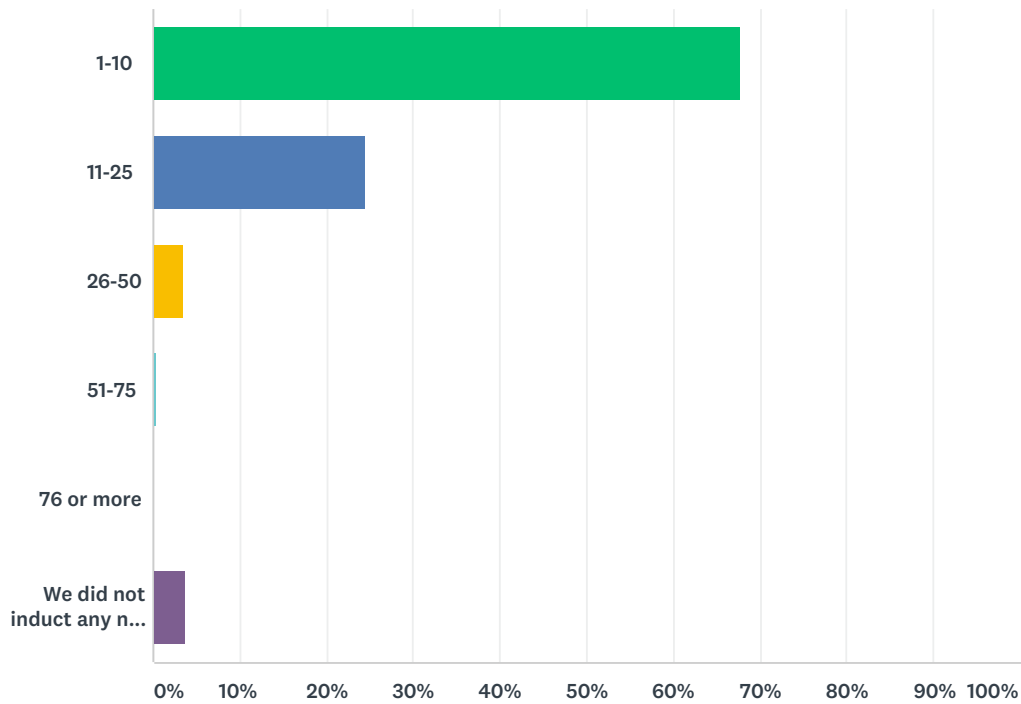

Q8 New Members: How many new members did your chapter induct during the 2017-2018 academic year?

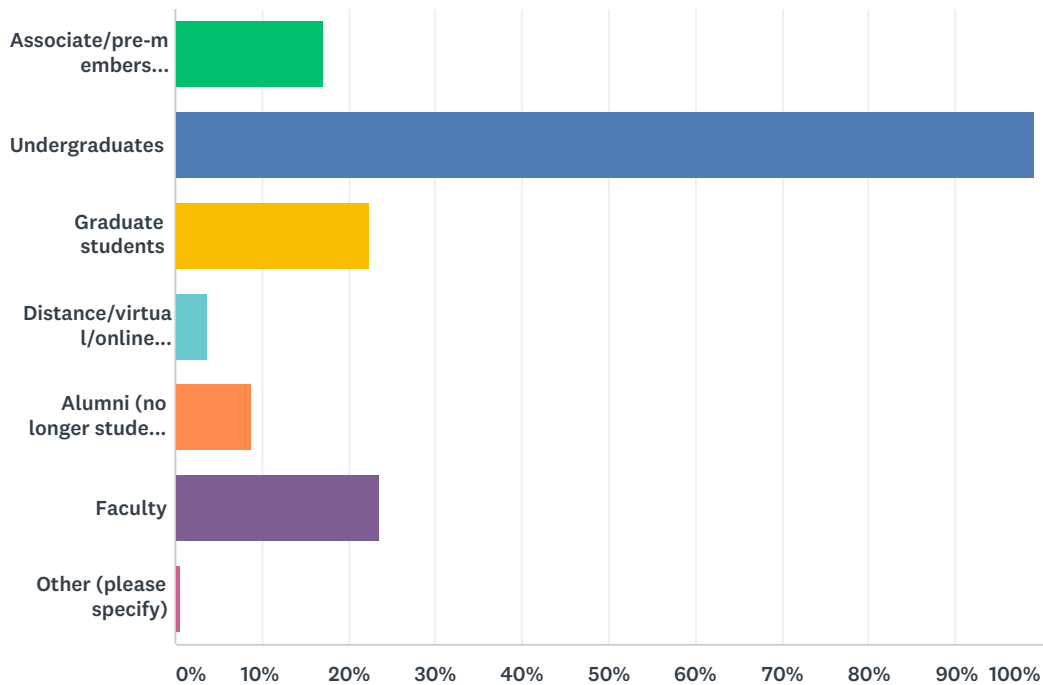

Q9 Chapter Membership: How would you categorize your chapter membership?(Check all that apply.)

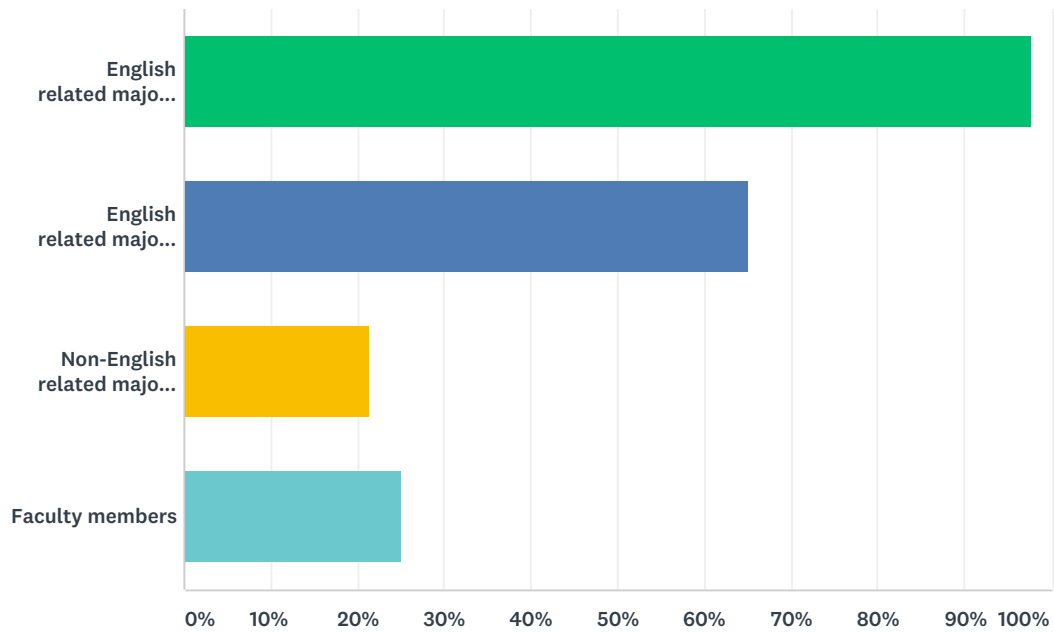

Q10 Chapter Membership: Please describe area(s) of study of your chapter members.(Check all that apply.)

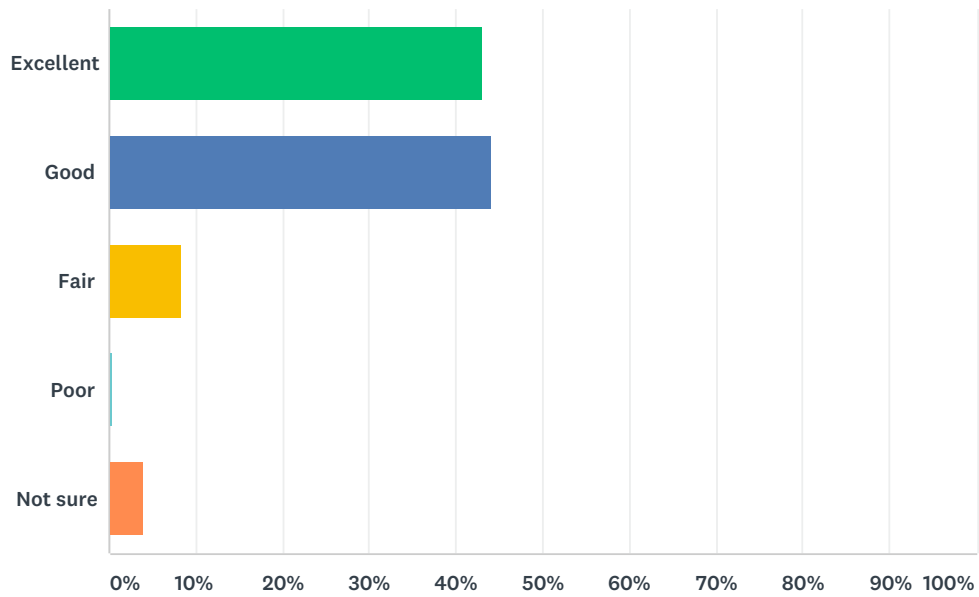

Q11 Chapter Image: How would you describe the image of your chapter in your department?

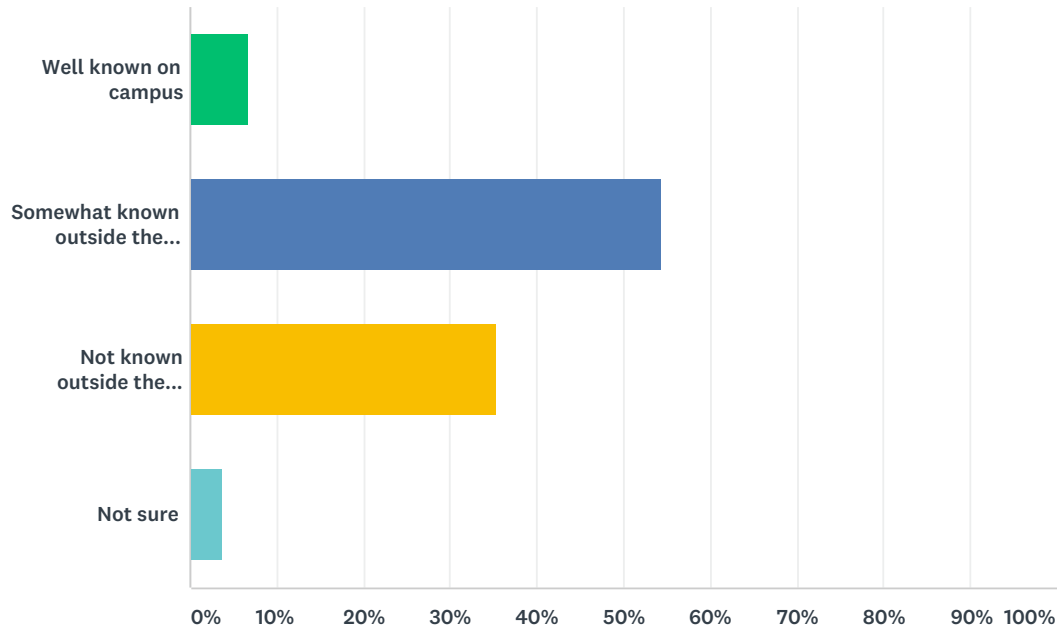

Q12 Chapter Image: How would you describe the image of your chapter on your campus?

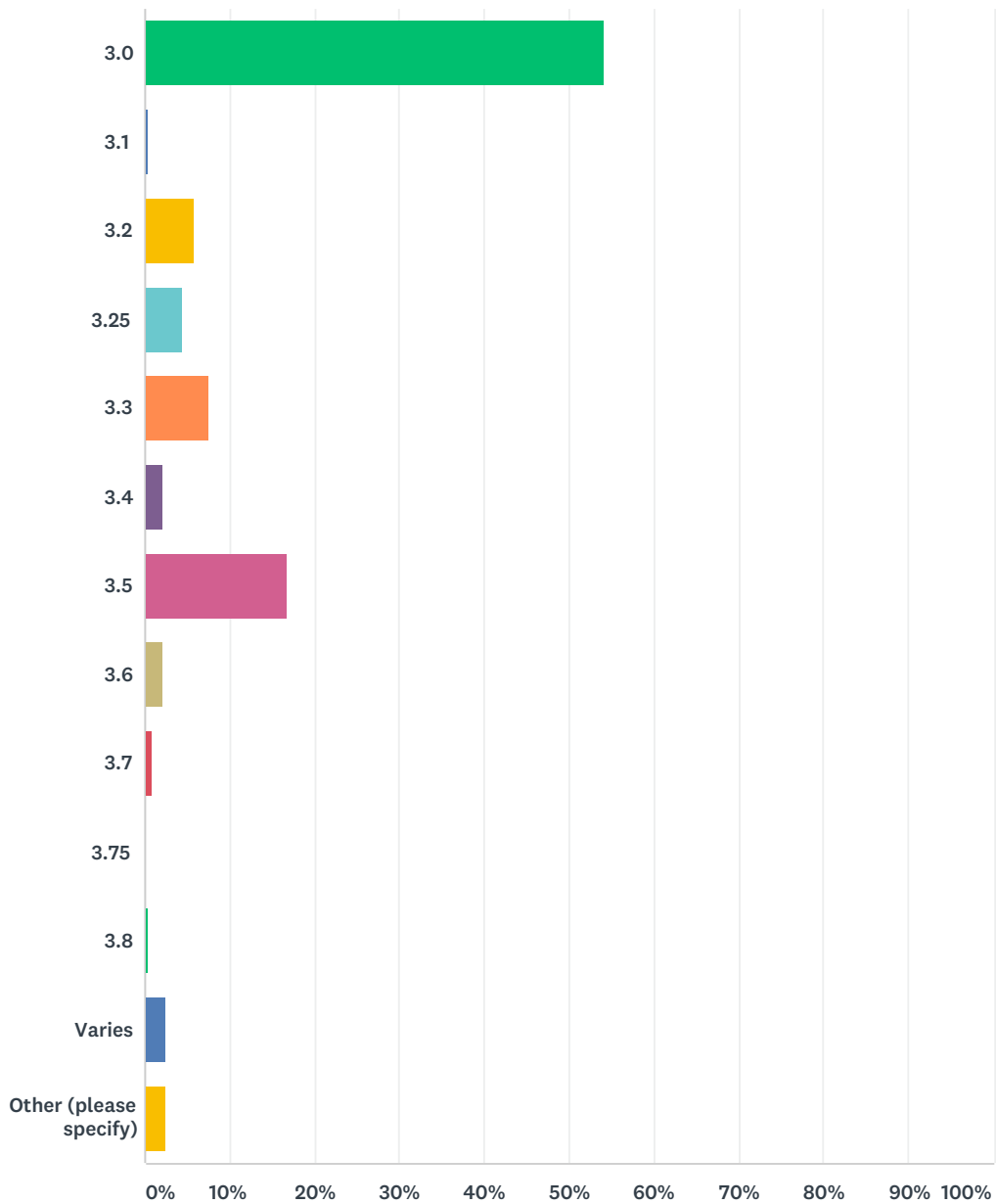

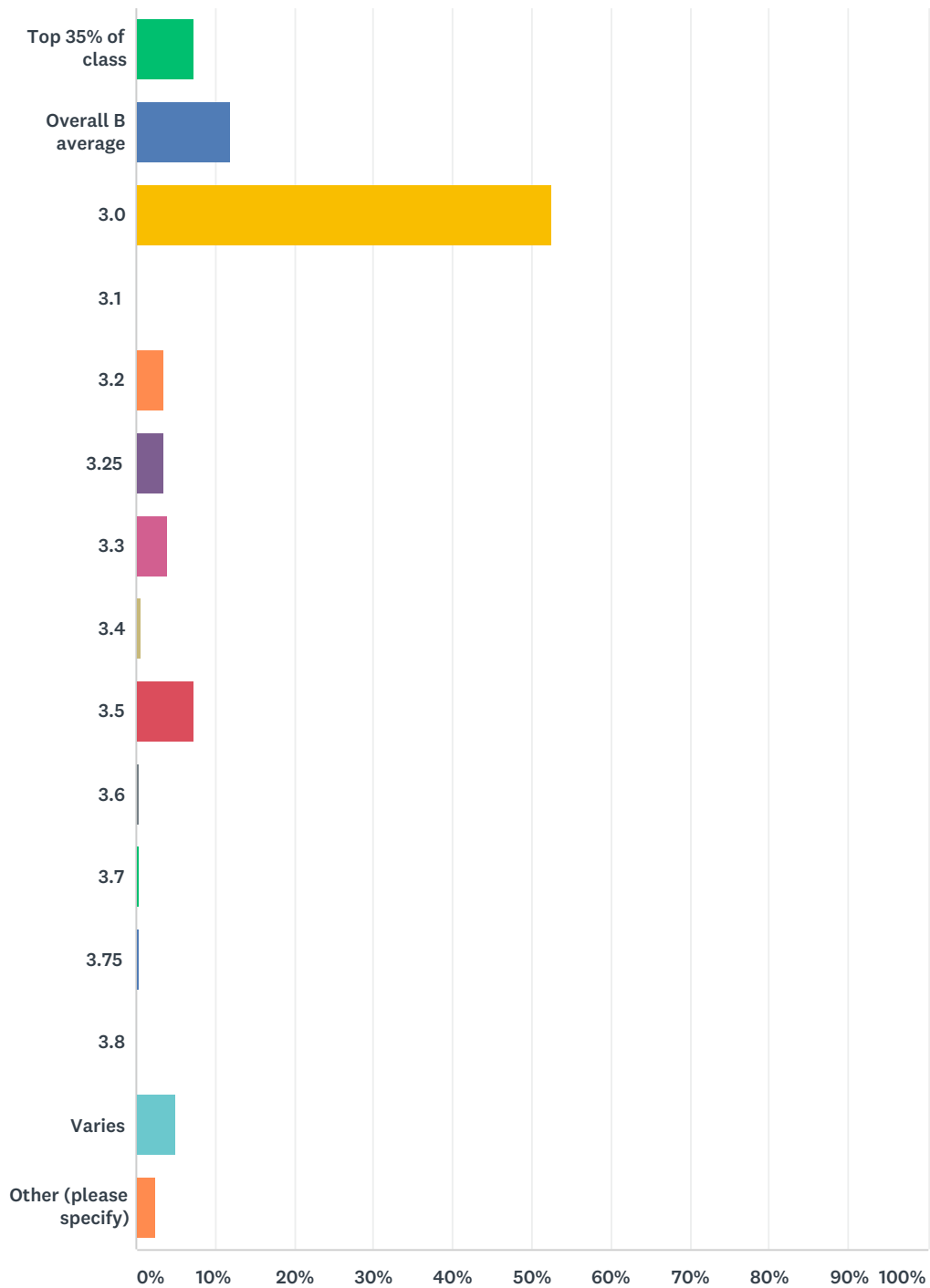

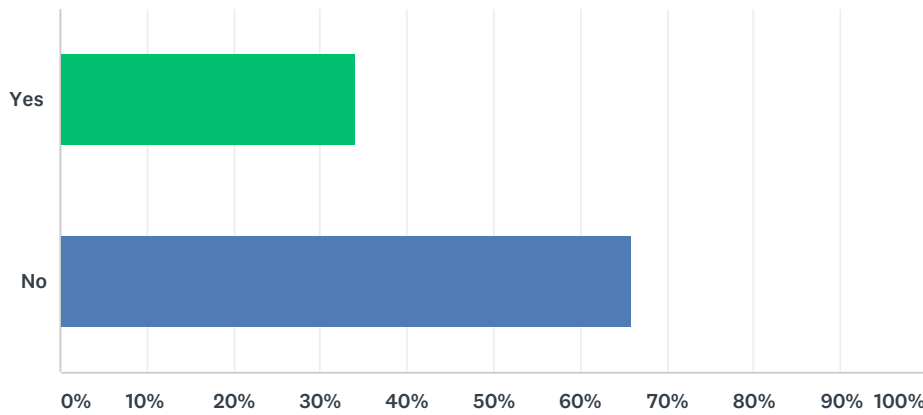

Q15 Local Dues: Does your chapter collect local dues (in addition to the current one-time international induction fee)?

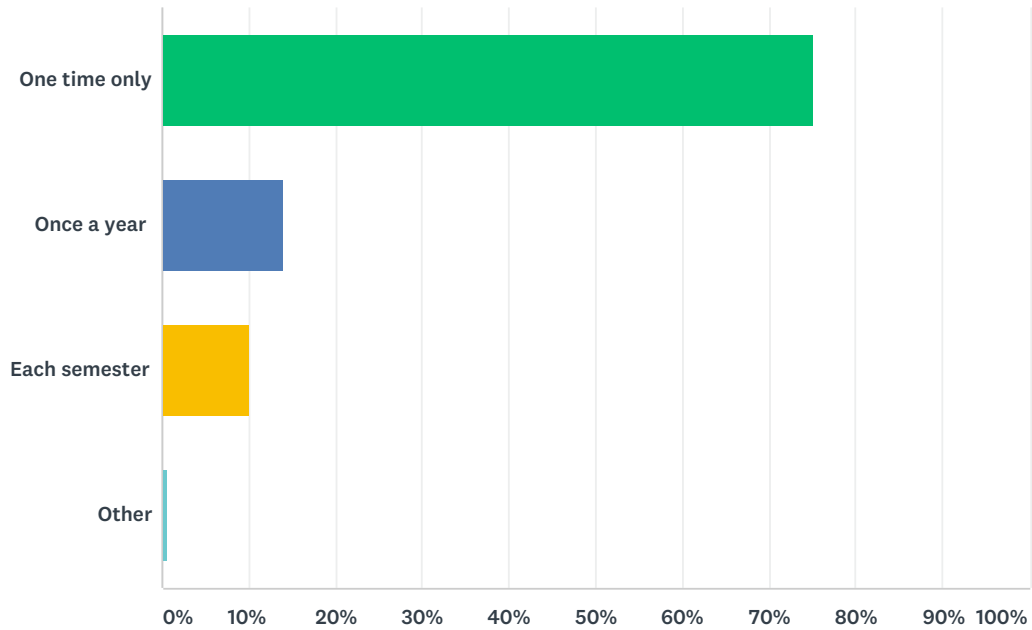

Q16 How often does your chapter collect local dues?

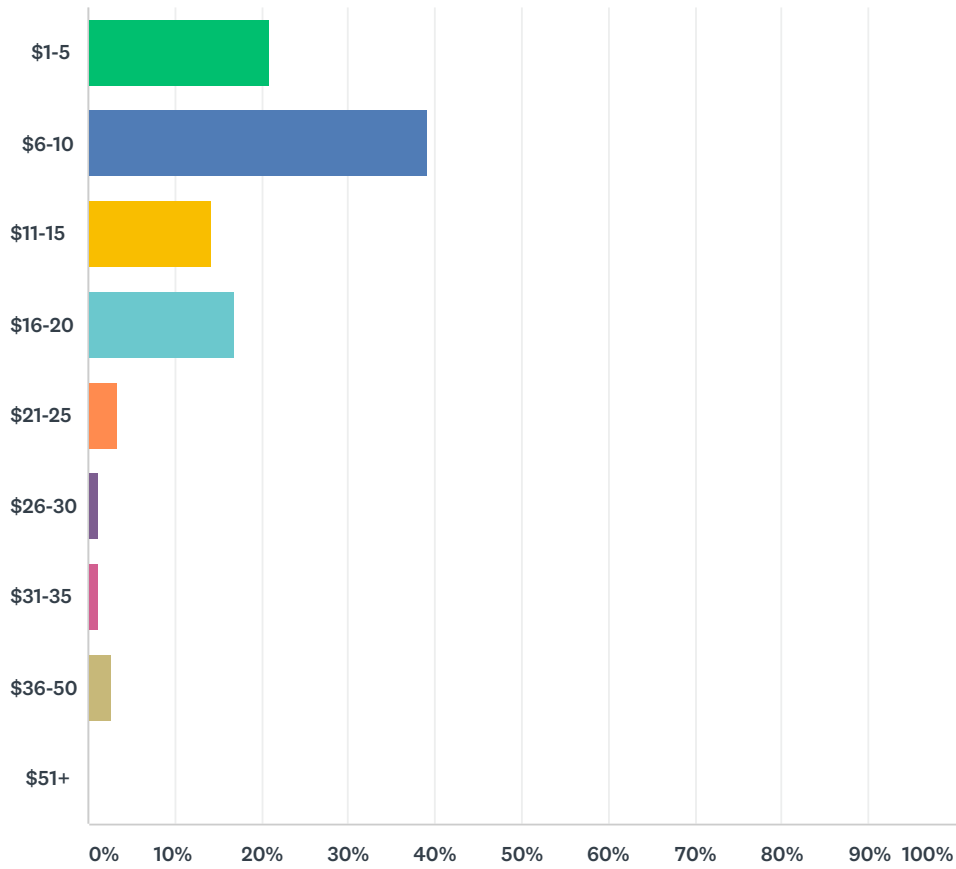

Q17 How much are your chapter's local dues?

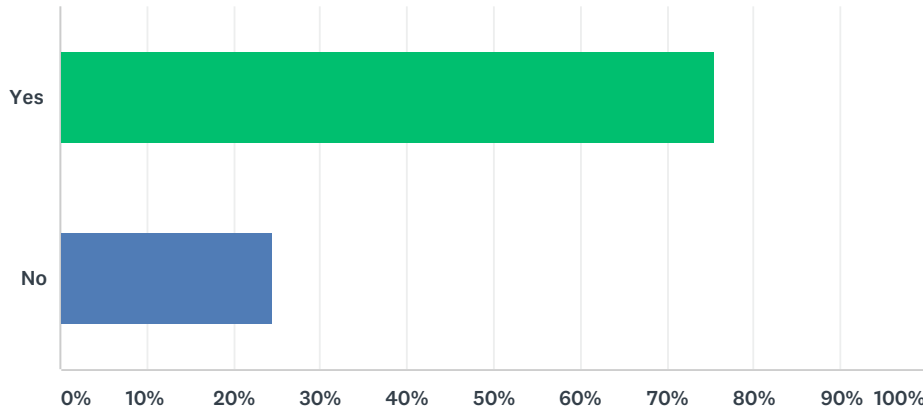

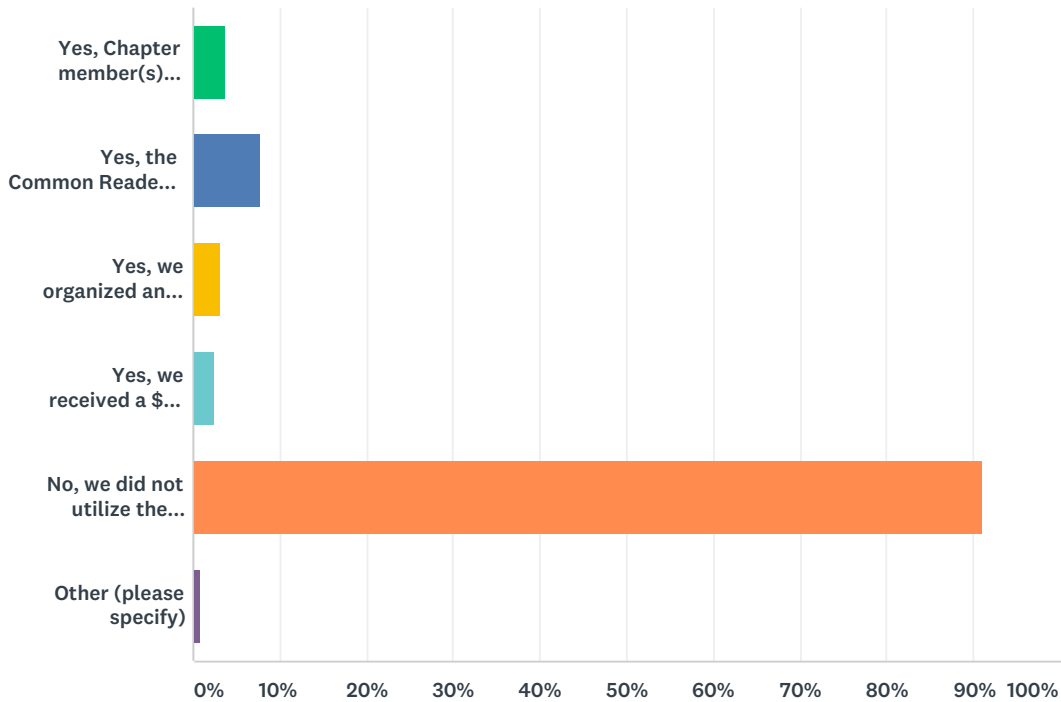

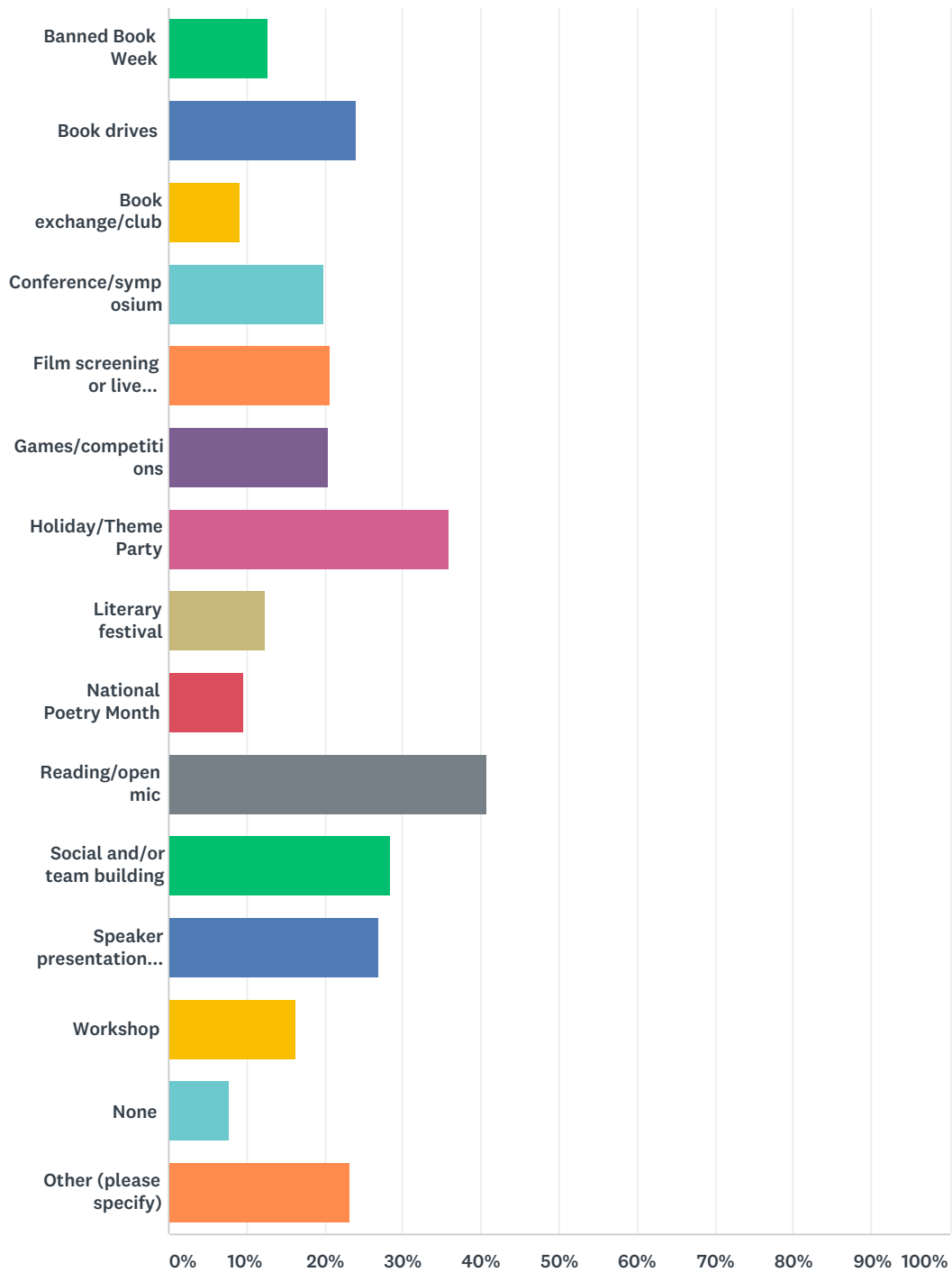

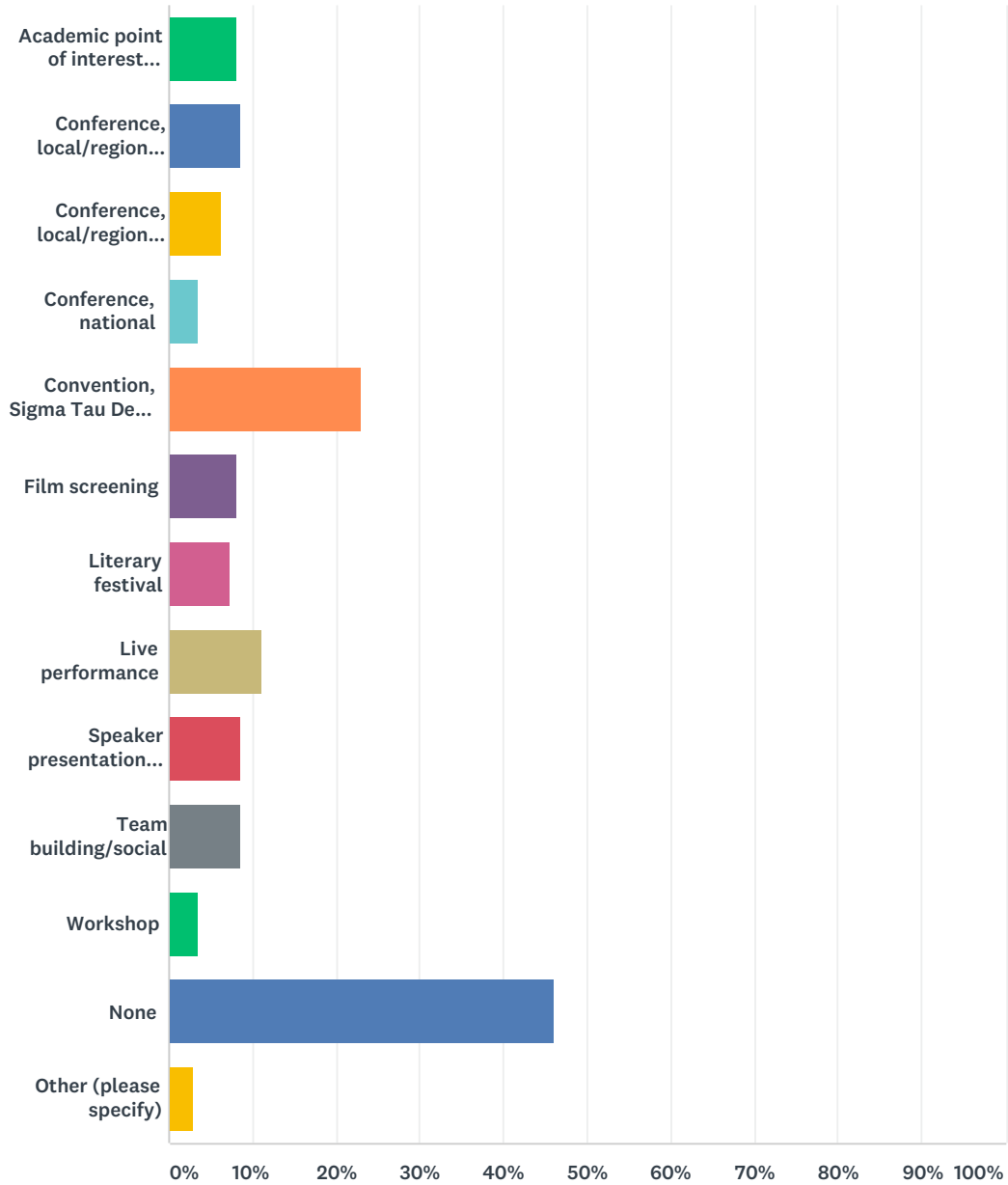

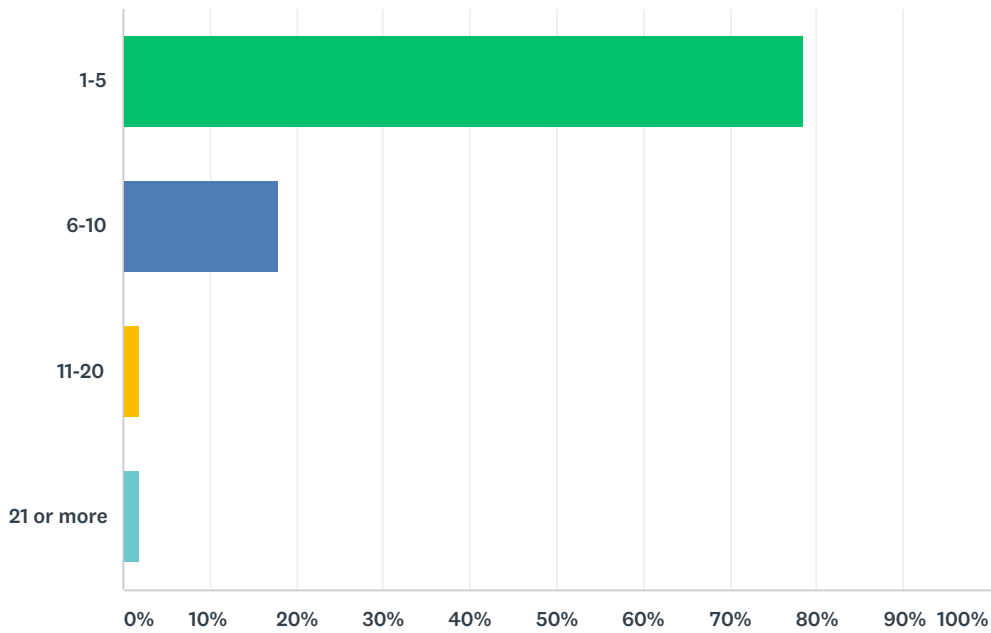

Q31 How many student members from your chapter attended the 2018 Convention?

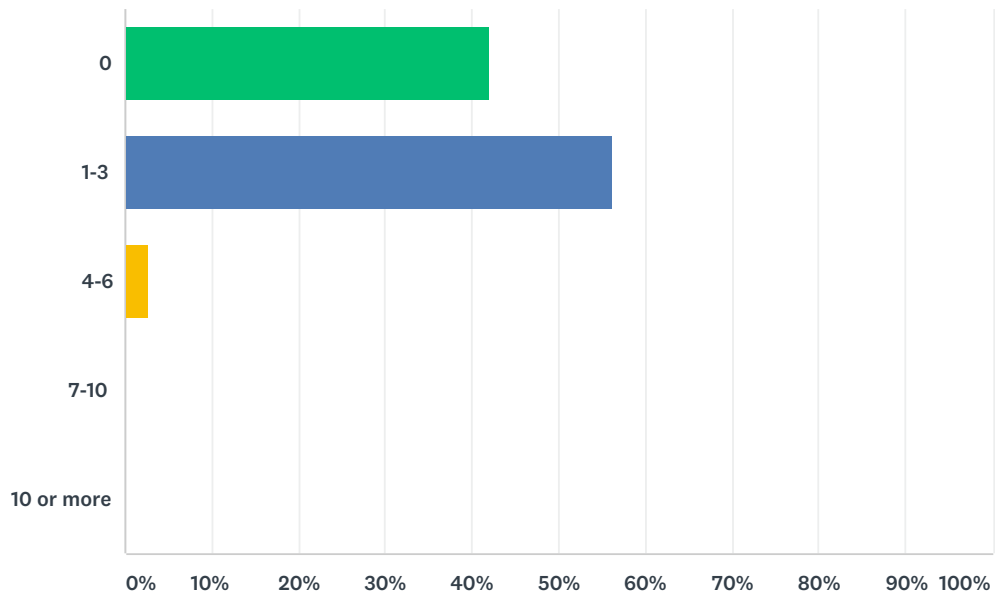

Q32 How many faculty members from your chapter/school attended the 2018 Convention?

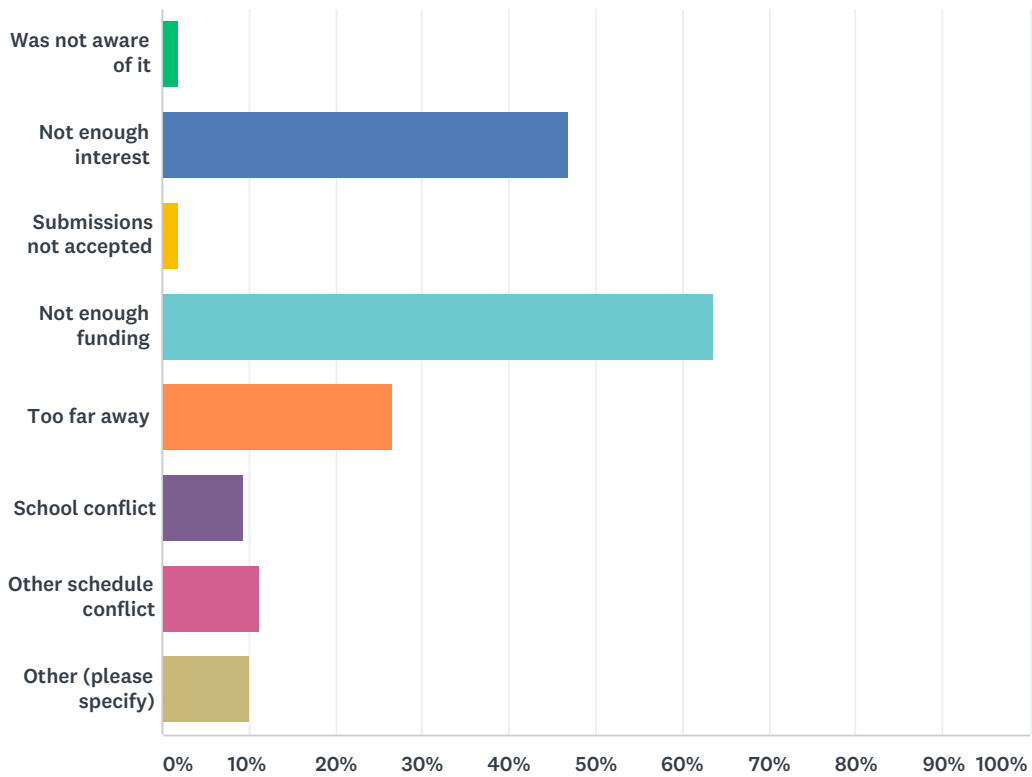

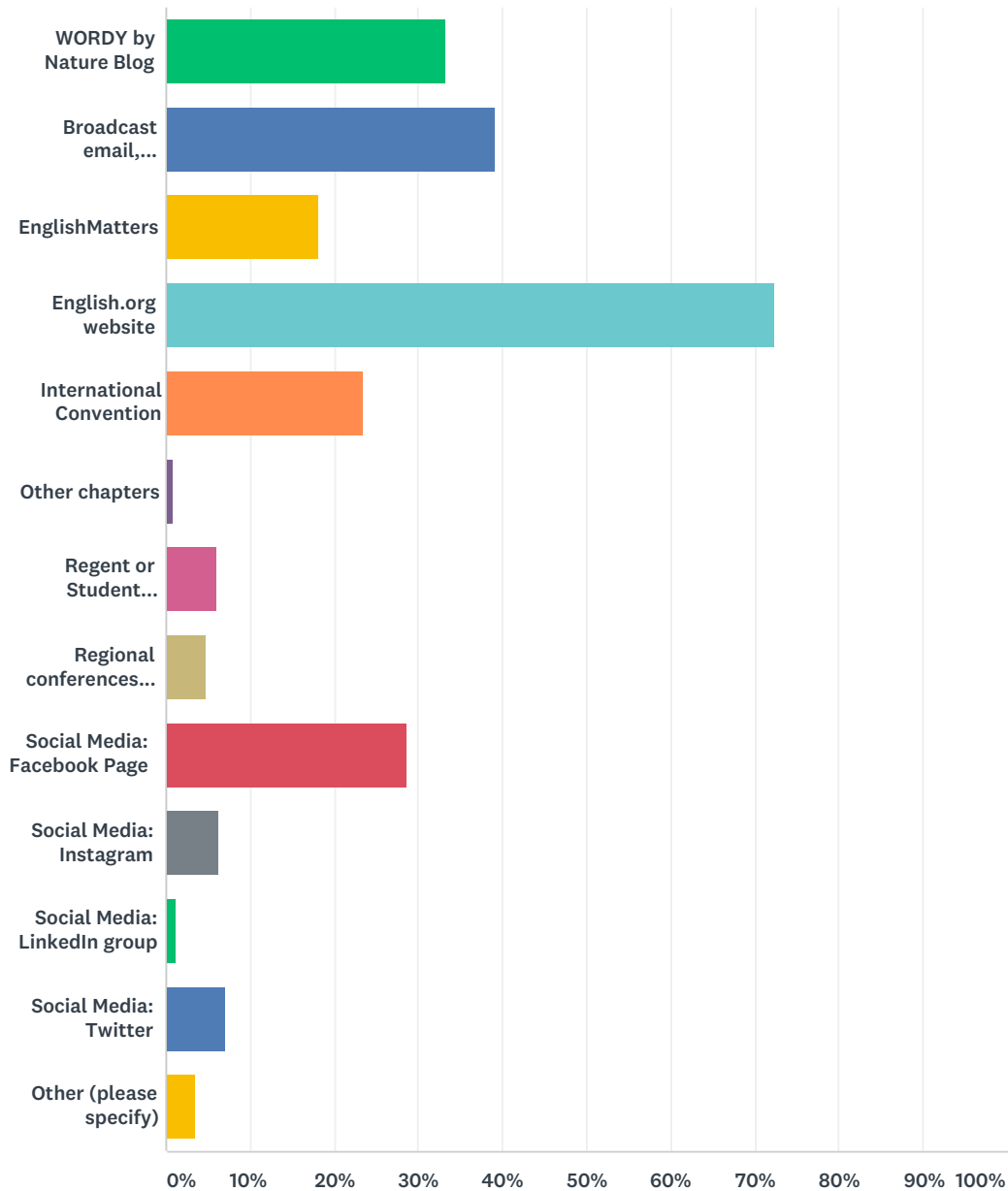

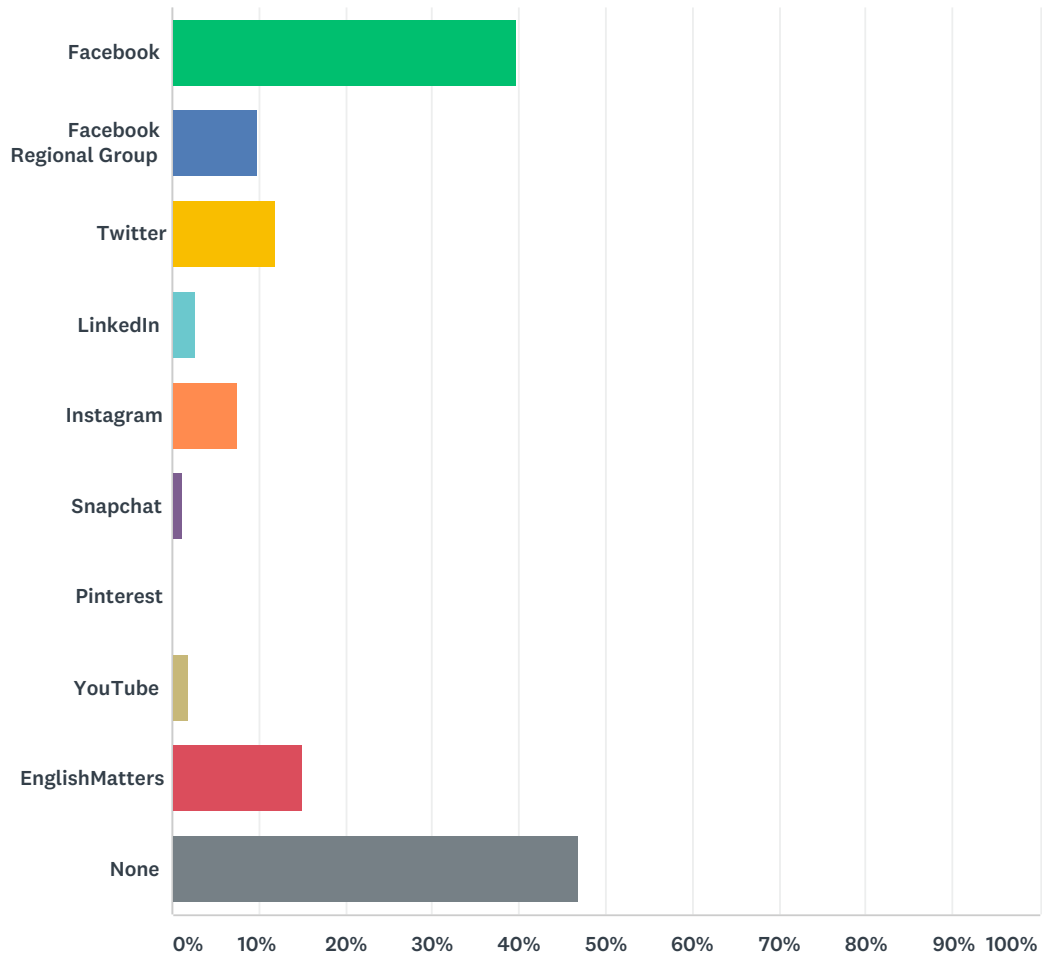

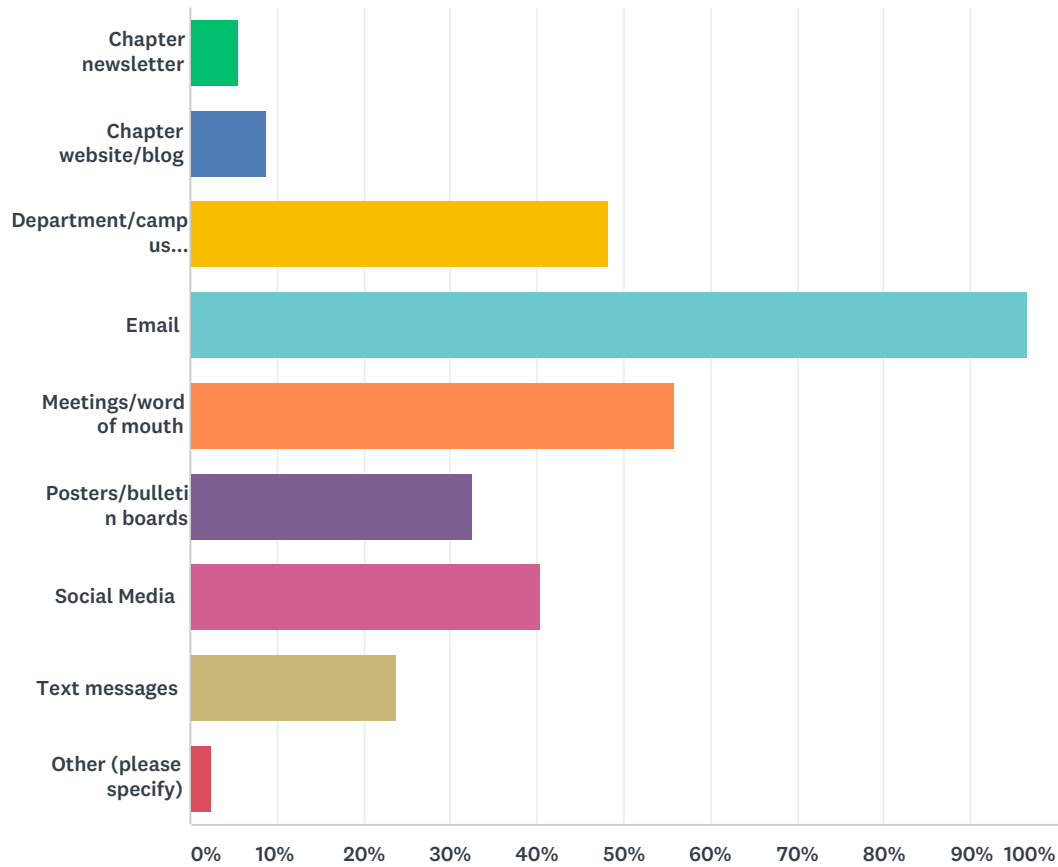

Q37 Chapter Communications: Which of the following ways do you and your chapter use to communicate with chapter members and/or to share information about your chapter with others? (Check all that apply.)

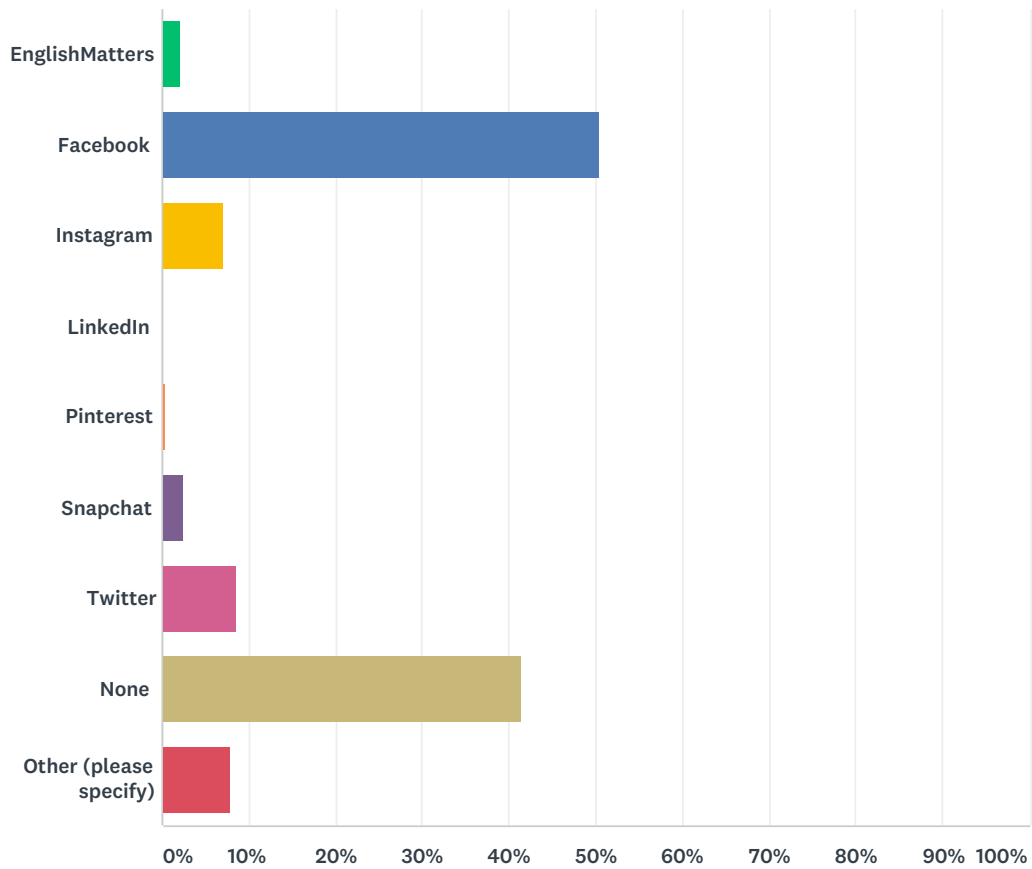
